

Motueka to Riwaka

Grade 2 | 0.5 to 1 hour | 11 km

Start: 1km south of central Motueka on Old Wharf Road.
Taste: Spectacular coastal scenery, estuary and sea birds including the majestic Kotuku; Raumanuka Reserve; Riwaka village for cafes; Hop Federation brewery is a few hundred metres back along the main road in Riwaka off the cycle trail.

Riwaka to Kaiteriteri

Grade 2-3 | 0.5 to 1 hour | 7 km

Start: Riwaka Domain.
Taste: Apple and kiwifruit orchards; hop gardens; Riwaka River suspension bridge; spectacular coastal views; Kaiteriteri Mountain Bike Park (Easy Rider); Kaiteriteri beach, recreation reserve and café.

Riwaka to Woodstock

On-road | 1.5 to 3 hours | 32 km

Start: Factory Road. Follow the signs to West Bank Road.
Prepare: We recommend taking your refreshments with you for this mainly rural section.
Taste: Beautiful scenery, orchards, hop gardens, farmland and native bush on quiet back-roads, between the Motueka River and the eastern boundary of Kahurangi National Park; Picturesque swimming and picnic spots.

Woodstock to Tapawera

On-road | 1 to 1.5 hours | 18 km

Prepare: This section is on the Motueka Valley Highway, following the Motueka River. Traffic can be busy, especially in summer. Please take care and keep left at all times.
Taste: Hill climbs; Country views; hop farms; Tapawera village and cafes, Railway Museum; War History Museum.

Tapawera to Kohatu

Grade 1 | 0.5 to 1 hour | 8 km

Prepare: This section follows the old railway corridor up the valley to Kohatu.
Taste: Kahurangi National Park to the west, hop plantations and river valley vistas. Kohatu Flat Rock Café, Hidden Sculpture Garden.

Kohatu to Wakefield

Grade 2 | 1.5 to 3 hours | 26 km

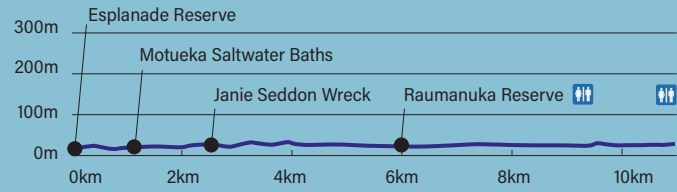
Prepare: Spooners Tunnel is dark and chilly, so bring lights and an extra layer.
Taste: Norris Gully Reserve; Spooners Tunnel; Belgrove and the historic railway windmill, Wai-iti River and native bush; Ewings free-range poultry farm; Wakefield village.

Wakefield to Richmond

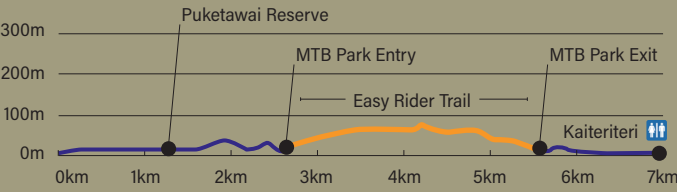
Grade 1 | 1 to 2 hours | 19 km

Taste: St John's Church; Native bush and rolling farmland; Lord Rutherford Memorial; Brightwater village for cafes, local pottery and crafts; Waimea River and suspension bridge; vineyards and wineries; Richmond township. This section has several wineries near the trail.

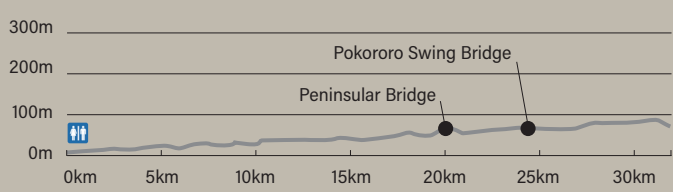
Motueka to Riwaka | Profile Map



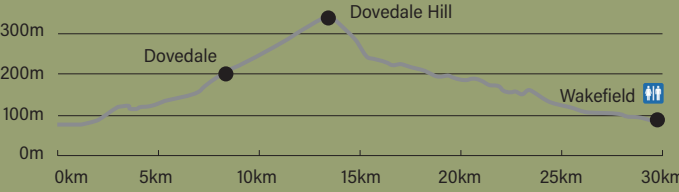
Riwaka to Kaiteriteri | Profile Map



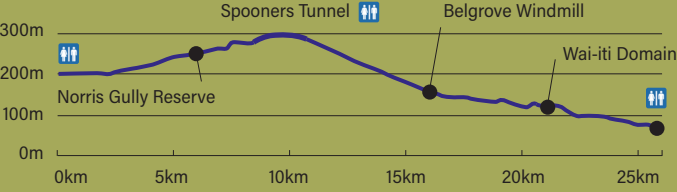
Riwaka to Woodstock | Profile Map



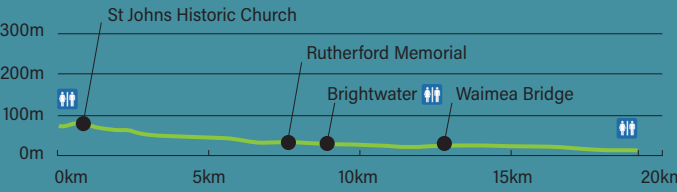
Woodstock to Wakefield | Profile Map

Nelson to Richmond

Grade 1 | 1 to 1.5 hours | 15 km

Start: Nelson i-site on Halifax Street
Taste: World of Wearable Arts and Classic Cars Museum; The Honest Lawyer; McCashin's Brewery; Pomeroy's Coffee Roastery Café; Pic's Peanut Butter World; Waimea Inlet.

Richmond to Mapua Ferry

Grade 1 | 1 to 2 hours | 20 km

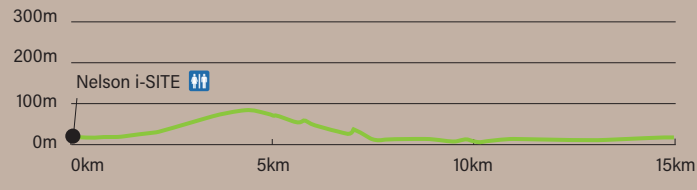
Start: Access the trail from Beach Road, or the west end of Champion Road near the ASB Aquatic Centre car park.
Taste: Coastal trail and board walks around the Waimea Inlet, home to many wading and sea birds; Waimea River suspension bridge; Rabbit Island; Mapua Ferry (times are sign posted) across to Mapua Wharf precinct for food or shopping.

Mapua to Motueka

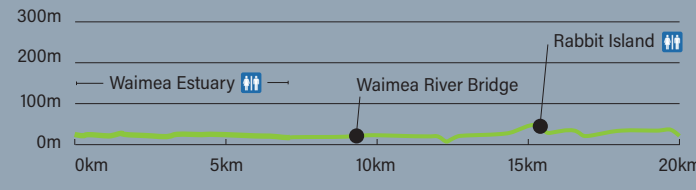
Grade 2-3 | 1.5 to 2.5 hours | 26 km

Start: Mapua Wharf
Taste: Apple orchards; hop gardens and vineyards; working artist studios and galleries; Jester House; Tasman vil-lag; 360° views of Tasman Bay and the Arthur Range; Riverside Community settlement and café; Toad Hall café and brewery; Motueka township.

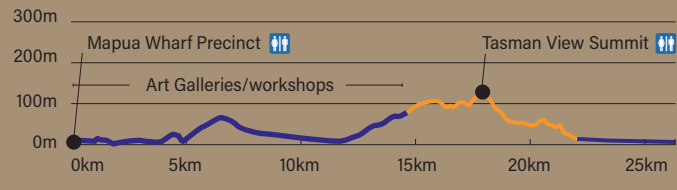
Nelson to Richmond | Profile Map

Riding the Great Taste Trail

Taste the extraordinary diversity of Nelson Tasman's towns, orchards, farms and vineyards, sparkling coastlines, rivers and hill valleys. Enjoy spectacular views, sample local food, wine or brews, spot wading and sea birds, and meet friendly locals.

The Great Taste Trail can be ridden all year round, and in either direction.

With many access points, you can choose a section and head out for a couple of hours, take the whole day, or enjoy a multi-day biking adventure.

Coastal sections are mostly flat, easy riding. There are a few more challenging grade 3 sections in the hill valleys.

Be sure to allow plenty of time to stop and enjoy the views, indulge in the eateries, and explore the nooks and crannies along the trail.

Ten trail sections are detailed on the reverse. See trail grade, ride times, gradient maps and trail 'tastes' to help you create your own adventure. Ride times do not include stops. Be sure to allow plenty of time to stop and enjoy the views, indulge in the eateries, and explore the nooks and crannies along the trail.

If you prefer, you can join a tour, or have someone tailor the adventure for you, arrange pick-ups, bike hire, food, accommodation and guides.
